



Rationale for Closure 2023-2024

- MSBA will not allow 2 projects at the same time
- PVMHS will be the next new school in Peabody
- Realistically, a new Center School will not be completed for about 7-10 years.
- The current heating and electrical systems will not last 10 years without significant renovations.
- Scope and timeline require relocation of students.

Work Completed in Summer 2023

- Abatement of floor tiles with ACM
- Replacement of floor tiles in main building
- Air quality testing
- Information and reports on website



Scope of Work for 2024-2025

- Heating System Upgrades
- Electrical Upgrades
- Ceiling Tile Replacement
- Bathrooms and plumbing
- Roof work

Current Demographics

- Enrollment 2022-2023: 446 students
- Open Enrollment:
 - 48 students (spring 2023)
 - 25-30 Kindergarten students (summer 2023)
- Current Enrollment: 349 students
 - 275 students K-4 to be relocated in 2024
- 155 Current Bus Students

Option 1: Move Integrated PreSchool to Centennial

- Benefits: 150 seats at McCarthy for Center School
 - Central location for PreSchool
- Drawbacks: Cost of buildout prohibitive
 - Property owners want long term lease (10-15 yrs)
- Conclusion: Not a viable option

- Option 2: Relocate Center students into existing classroom space in other 7 elementary schools
- Benefits: Mathematically, we have enough seats across the district to do this
- Drawbacks: Center students spread across too many schools. Transportation a major challenge.
- Conclusion: Not the best option

Use of the Annex

- Annex classrooms require less work than classrooms in the main building
- Work can be completed over the summer
- 10 classroom spaces including student bathrooms
- Separate entrance from main building

Option 3: Relocate grades 4 and 5 to Annex

- Benefits: Allow older students to stay at Center
- Drawbacks: Annex classrooms built for younger students. Splitting up siblings. No gym, kitchen or main office. Transportation still a major challenge.
- Conclusion: Not a viable option

Option 4: Keep students in K and 1 in the Annex

- Benefits: Allow some students to stay at Center
- Drawbacks: Incoming K students have never attended Center. Splitting up siblings. No gym, kitchen or main office. No space for specialist teachers. Transportation still a major challenge.
- Conclusion: Not a viable option

Option 5: Relocate Integrated PreSchool to the Annex

- Benefits: 150 seats at McCarthy for Center School
 - Majority of Center Students in 2-3 schools
 - Keep Siblings and Neighborhoods together
 - Transportation similar to current configuration
 - Central location for PreSchool
- Conclusion: Preferred Option

Process for School Selection 2024 - 2025


Priorities:

- Keep siblings together (more than 60 sets)
- Keep Neighborhoods together
- Provide transportation to newly assigned school
- Offer options through open enrollment process

Process for School Selection 2024 - 2025

Process

- All students will be assigned a new neighborhood school for 2024-2025
- Transportation will be provided to assigned school
- Center students given priority for Open Enrollment
 - Transportation NOT provided for open enrollment
- Individual meetings are encouraged
