With a population of over 55,000, Peabody is a culturally diverse city located fifteen miles north of Boston in Essex County. Historically recognized as the "Tanner City" due to its prominent leather industry, Peabody has evolved into a diverse and thriving community with a blend of residential, commercial and cultural assets. Peabody is home to eight elementary, one middle and two high schools, including the comprehensive Peabody Veterans Memorial High School and the alternative Peabody PREP High School.

School

Peabody Veterans Memorial High School, established in 1850, is a comprehensive public high school serving 1,272 students in grades 9 through 12. The school emphasizes academic excellence, personal growth and college and career readiness, offering a wide variety of courses including: Advanced Placement (AP) classes, honors program, and Career-Technical Education (CTE). CTE programming includes: Culinary, Cosmetology, Early Childhood Education, Electronics & Engineering, Medical Assisting and Protective Services. In addition to academics, PVMHS provides students with opportunities to engage in athletics, the arts, and extracurricular activities that foster leadership, collaboration and community involvement. PVMHS has a seven period school day where full year classes are worth 5 credits and semester long classes are worth 2.5 credits.

Course Levels (see GPA weights below)

Advanced Placement: All AP teachers have been trained and follow the College Board AP curriculum. Students are expected to take the AP exam as part of their course expectations. Earns GPA increase.

Dual Enrollment: Dual Enrollment courses are taken outside of the seven period schedule. They appear on student transcripts but do not calculate into student's GPA or rank.

Honors: Accelerated in nature, require a teacher recommendation, extensive work outside of school and earns Honors GPA increase.

College Prep: Challenging coursework, some work outside of school, CP GPA weight.

Unleveled/Ungraded: These courses are graded but not leveled. They are not part of GPA or Class Rank.
